Health /Hip Contract

We (Von Schiedel's English Mastiffs),
Guarantee our puppies to be without congenital defect when sold.
You have the availability to see health certifications and pedigrees as public record on our web site to verify the best possible health of the puppies' descendants, therefore producing proven health for the best health in your puppy.

This contract outlines our rights and responsibilities in the event your puppy is not well.

- In the event that a puppy is purchased with a contagious illness, we will be happy to help with ½ the vet bills when our budget allows for it, pending proof from licensed DVM. However for this to be enforced, a vet must examine the puppy no more than 72 hours after the purchase, with no exceptions. If the puppy becomes sick more than 72 hours after purchase, and a vet exam was not performed before then, we are no longer responsible for the pup's care.
- In the event a puppy is purchased with a congenital defect which is life threatening or non treatable, we will immediately accept the puppy back in exchange for a replacement puppy. If no replacement is available at this time, we will provide a suitable one in no more than 1 year and 6 months. If the congenital defect is not life threatening or non treatable, depending on the defect and the treatment of sic, we we'll refund part of the purchase price to help provide care for the puppy. The amount refunded will be decided by us (the breeder) after speaking to the puppies' veterinarian and reading over the appropriate courses of treatment. If, at that time of the discovery, the puppy was purchased, no more than 2 weeks prior and there are still suitable puppies available, the purchaser has the option of exchanging the puppy for another. If another is not available the above statements will be carried out. This is a legally binding and enforceable as of the date of this purchase.

It is your responsibility to have the dogs Hips, Elbows, Thyroids and Patella's checked out by the appropriate doctors at the age of 2 for your own health papers, and to forward them to the OFA to be certified at your expense.
